Friends at Blatchington Mill '200' Club Rules

- The applicant, by signing this application form, will join a club to be known as the Friends at Blatchington Mill '200' Club and become one of its 200 members.
- The rules of the '200' Club are set out below.

RULES

1. The object of the '200' Club is to raise funds for the benefit of Blatchington Mill School.
2. The '200' Club will be managed by the '200' Club Manager (appointed annually by the FAB).
3. Membership will be limited to 200.
4. Members must be aged over 16 at the date of application.
5. In the event of more than 200 people applying for membership, membership will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis, with excess applications being given preference in the next annual cycle of membership.
6. Each member will pay an annual membership fee of £10 (for each school year).
7. Membership fees should be paid by 30th September in each year, where possible.
8. Each member will be allocated a unique, sequential, number between 1 & 200.
9. The '200' Club manager will undertake a supervised draw in the 2 weeks prior to each half-term (i.e.: there will be 3 draws per school year).
10. The prizes, based on a full membership of 200, will be as follows:

1st - £200 2nd - £100 3rd - £33

In the event of full membership not being reached, prizes will be reduced proportionally.

11. All prizes will be paid by crossed cheque sent to the address given by the relevant member. If a prize cheque has not been banked within 6 months of its issue date, the cheque will be cancelled and the money will revert to the fund.
12. Prize winners will be notified by post and a list of winners will be posted at the School.
13. Members of the '200' Club are responsible for informing the manager of any change of address.
14. The manager will maintain records of all members and prize winners.
15. Any disputes will be determined by the FAB and their decision shall be final.
