

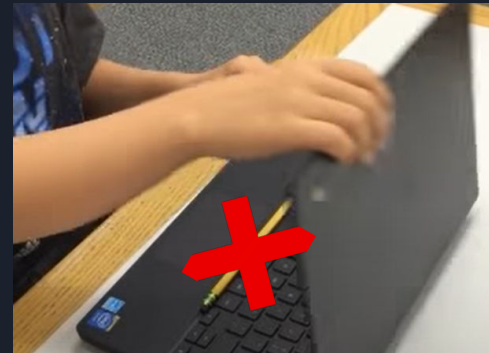
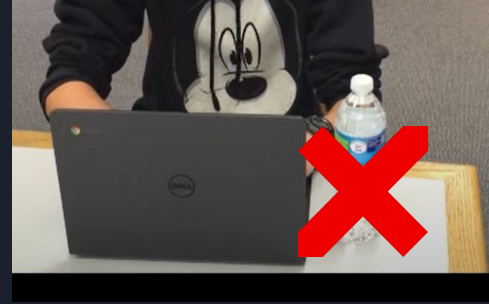

# Looking after the Chromebook (2)

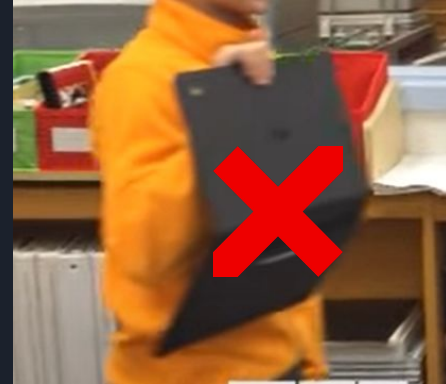
- No food or drink next to Chromebooks.
- Cords, cables, and USB disks must be inserted carefully into appropriate port
- Be aware of power cord as a tripping hazard.
- Chromebooks must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, and labels(except the school labels).
- Objects should never be placed on top of Chromebooks.



# Looking after the Chromebook (3)

## Carrying Chromebooks

- Always transport Chromebooks with care
- Hold the Chromebooks (cover closed) with two hands to carry it anywhere inside or outside of the classroom.
- Never lift a Chromebook by the screen.
- Never carry a Chromebook with the screen open.



# Looking after the Chromebook (4)

## Powering your Chromebook

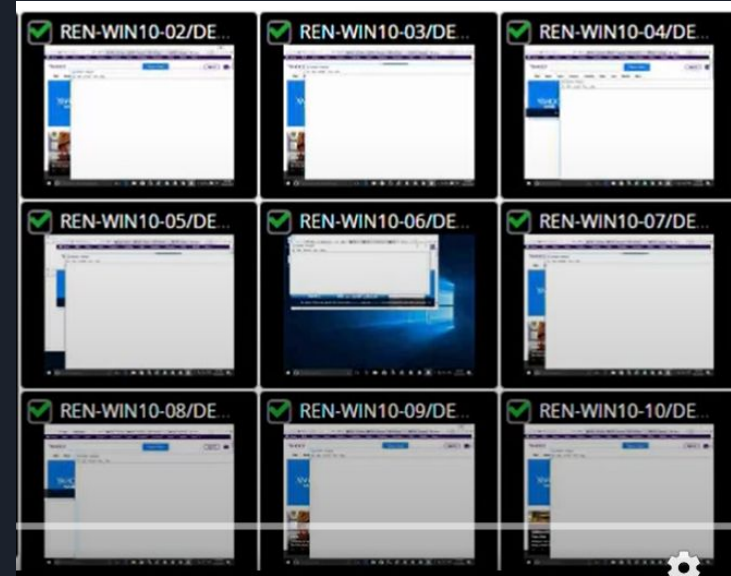
- Chromebooks are required to be fully charged when you arrive at school each day.
- When charging, be sure to place the Chromebook in an area that will prevent people from tripping from the power cord. This could injure the person and/or damage the Chromebook.
- Determine a consistent place to charge your Chromebook at home.



# Looking after the Chromebook (5)

## Other important reminders

- Anything you do on the Internet (on any device) is visible to someone
- Pictures, music, etc., on your Chromebook should be appropriate for school
- At School we use **SENSO** to monitor your activity to keep you safe. Use the chromebook for educational purposes.



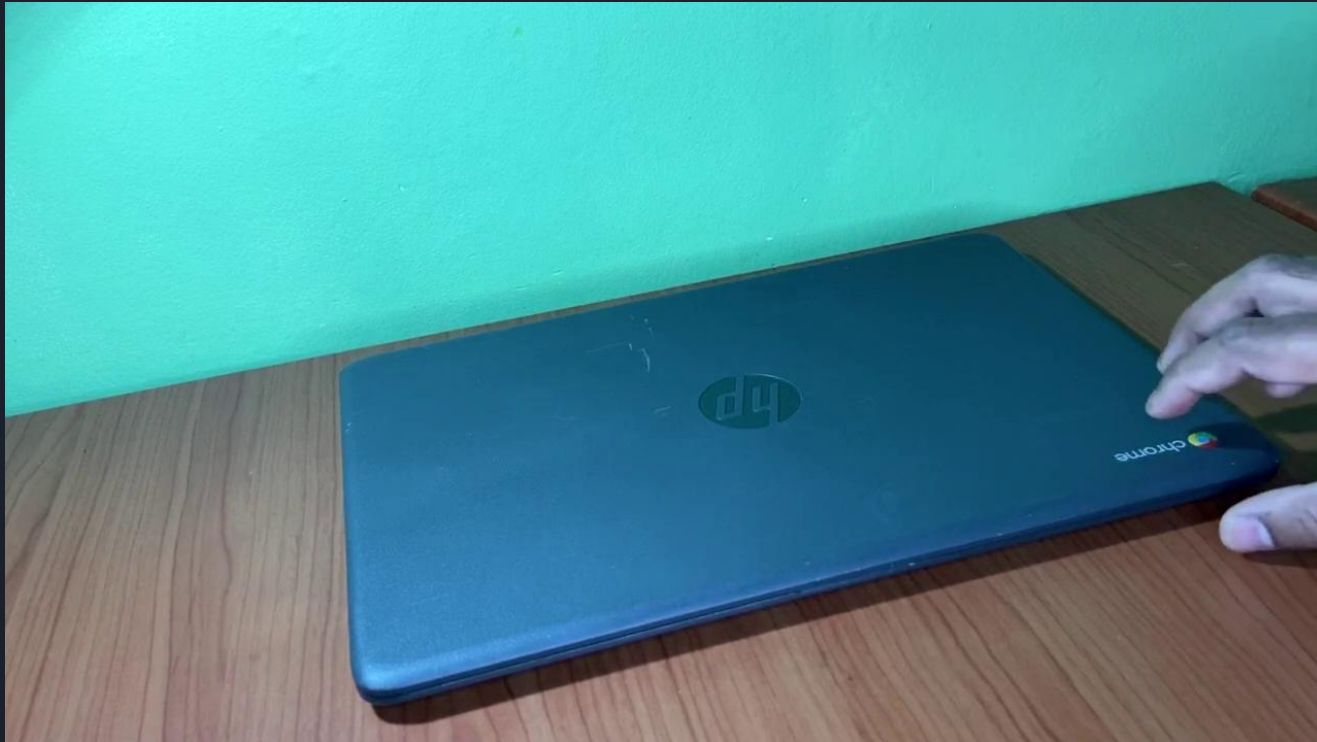

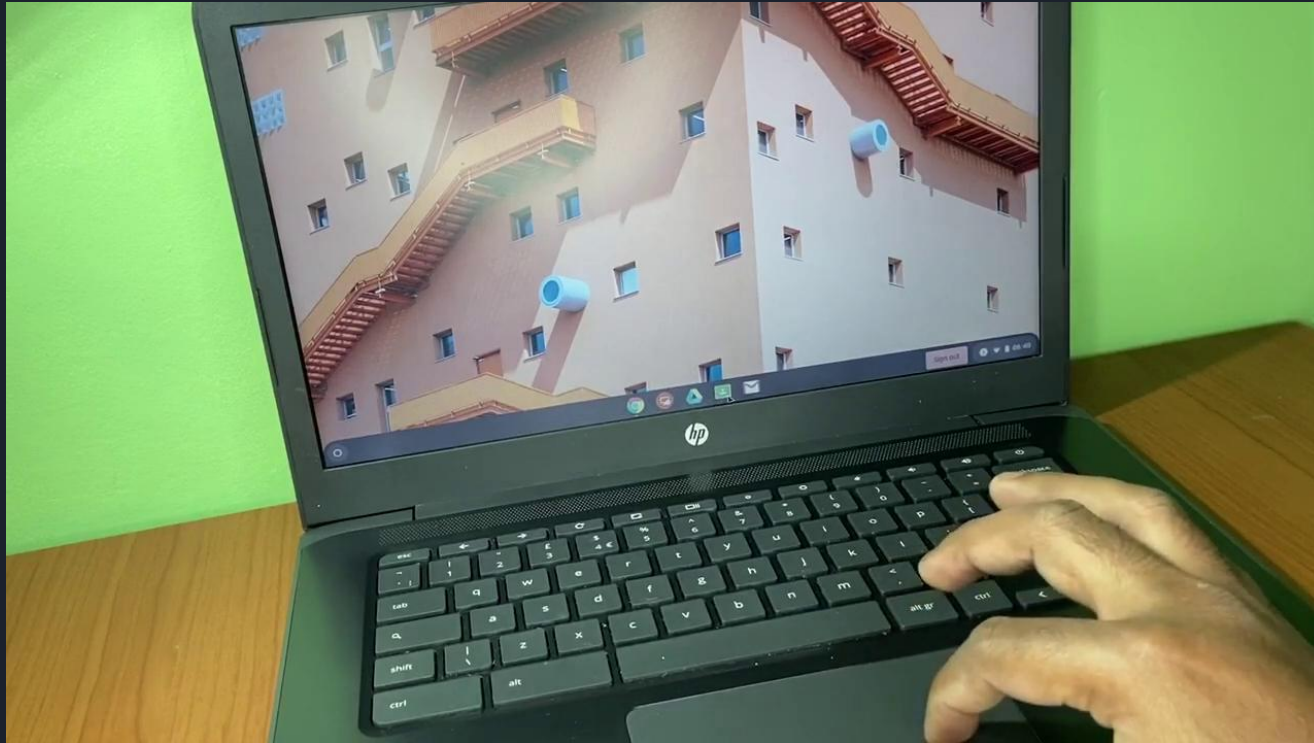
