This mailshot also contains information on FAB (Friends at Blatch - our parent teacher association) and Internet Safety: We are aware that mobile phones have become even more popular as children move into secondary school and if we can develop good e-habits in our children now, it may keep them safe in the future.

A mailshot in late June with an invitation for your child to spend the day at Blatch (Friday 3rd July), details of the Year 6 Parents/Carers' Evening (Monday 6th July at 6.30pm), school uniform information and a Welcome to Blatch guide from our current Year 7s to your child.

The final 'mailshot' before the summer break will contain details of the Induction Day in September, information on locker leasing and reminders about school uniform (including the dates over the summer that uniform will be available to purchase on the school site).
