Outside of school, we are very aware that one of the significant points of transition to secondary school is the independence of a child walking to and from school. Often they will not be accompanied by parents/carers. We always recommend that students arrange to walk or cycle with each other where possible and that routes are planned and even trialled over the summer.

School finishes at 3pm each day. There will be multiple opportunities for your child/children to take part in after school clubs, homework/help sessions and activities. We produce an Extra-Curricular Activity Calendar by the end of September each year; this details the activities on offer after school for the rest of the academic year. There is no cost for these activities.
